

## MIXED EMOTIONS LARGE DIE GAME

## What You Need:

6 Pieces of sturdy board or foam core Scissors

Sticky paper to print onto or plain paper with double-sided tape
Small figurines or paper cut-outs to put into the box
Duct tape / packaging tape

## **Directions:**

- For this project, you will need to cut five 8" square pieces using your sturdy board or foam core. For the last side you will need one, 8" square piece with a 1-2" tab along one of the sides. This will be the last piece you place, the tab will help to "lock" this side into place.
- Once all of your pieces are cut out, you will attach them to each other on the inside using the tape at each seam. Attach each piece to the next creating a die shape.
- Once the four sides are attached you can then attach the top and bottom pieces, leaving the final piece with the tab for last.
- 4. On the Mixed Emotion panel, make sure to cut out a circle on both the printed paper and the sturdy board/foam core. This is the spot that the figurine will fall out of, when shaken.
- Once your die has been created, you can then cut out your printed pages to 8"x 8". It's recommended to use a sticky paper with a full adhesive backing.
- 6. Take your figurines and place them into your die it's time to play! As each kid shakes the die, an emotion will fall out. Whichever character falls out during the child's turn he/she will have to share a memory or story from their own childhood that reflects the same emotion.
